1. **Key statements for the EBRNetwork** – the following text was suggested for the **aim** (changes from the previous aim are highlighted in red):

The aim of the EBRNetwork is to promote evidence-based research by endorsing:

- a. No new studies without prior systematic review of existing evidence
- b. Efficient production, updating, and accessibility of systematic reviews

The following was suggested for the **definition** of evidence-based research (changes from the previous definition are highlighted in red):

Evidence-based research is the use of prior research in a systematic and transparent way to inform a new study so that it is answering questions that matter in a valid, efficient and accessible manner.

We decided not to change the definition of evidence-based research to include research-on-research, but rather add it as a method to achieve our aim. The following methods/tasks were identified as ways to achieve our aims:

- a. Meta-research
- b. Involve consumers
- c. Develop methods to be evidence-based
- d. Partner up with important stakeholders
- e. Automation of preparing systematic reviews
